IHA Board of Trustees

The Idaho Hospital Association is governed by an 18-member Board of Trustees. The composition includes 14 hospital chief executive officers (CEOs), 3 hospital trustee representatives, and the IHA President. Eight CEOs are elected from their Regional Leadership Council. Other members include the Chair of the Board, Chair-elect, Immediate Past Chair, Secretary-Treasurer and two AHA Delegates. IHA policy is established by the Board of Trustees acting upon recommendations made by various committees.

IHA Regional Leadership Councils (RLCs)

Geographically, IHA is divided into three regional leadership councils: Northern, Southwest and Southeast. The councils meet twice annually for the purposes of discussing key IHA issues. Each member is assigned to an RLC based on geographic location.
