PEOPLE IN BUSINESS: ISU College of Business hires EIRMC CEO as executive in residence

The Idaho State University College of Business has brought in its first executive in residence, Doug Crabtree, to the health care administration programs.

Crabtree recently retired from Eastern Idaho Regional Medical Center where he was CEO for 18 years. As the program's executive in residence, Crabtree will take the role as instructor in both graduate- and undergraduate-level health care administration and master of health care administration programs, a university news release said.

In this role, Crabtree will also use his extensive background working in the health care administration field to provide academic program directors and the College of Business dean with advice in the initial launch of the master of health care administration program.
